

## Former Railways of Spain

## Inland Alicante region. Tour number PM2205

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 17th September 2022

This tour explores some of the history behind the railway lines that once ran through this area. Most of the rides are on the former railway lines themselves so are relatively flat. Lights will be needed as we cycle through many tunnels. Based in the County town of Cocentaina, which has all the amenities you might need, we will be staying in a comfortable guest house. This week is graded 2, leisurely, with the longest day being 45kms. The pace will be very leisurely, with plenty of time for sightseeing, coffee breaks and lunch. We will also stop to talk about aspects of the railways from time to time.

Dates:- Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> September – Saturday 17th September 2022

Price:- £475 (plus £85 single supplement) to include,

7 nights bed, breakfast and evening meal. Transfers from/to Alicante airport, maps, GPS files, route sheets. Bikexplore and tour leaders' expenses.

Maximum number of participants – 8. There is no minimum number, the holiday will go ahead regardless of numbers booked.



Itinerary:-

**Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2022.** Transfer from Alicante airport. If time after assembling bikes, short ride to Turballos. 19kms, 200 metres ascent.

**Sunday 11**<sup>th</sup> **September.** Today we will take the Serpis Via Verde to Gaianes, then drop down to the where the river feeds the lake. 23kms, 260 metres ascent.

**Monday 12**<sup>th</sup> **September.** Today we ride on more of the Serpis which goes all the way to the coast at Gandia, but we will only cycle to Lorcha. In fact, we will reach Lorcha by road, and return on the Serpis Via Verde. 45kms, 520 metres ascent.


**Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> September.** A different railway line, the Xixarra goes North before swinging West. We will go as far as Bocairent, a fascinating village with much to see, including its interesting window caves. 45kms, 486 metres ascent.

**Wednesday 14**<sup>th</sup> **September.** We take the Via Verde (former railway line) through Alcoy, which affords spectacular views without any steep climbing. We pass through many tunnels along the way (lights required). 44kms, 536 metres ascent.


**Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> September**. Market day in Cocentaina. A day off the bike to wander around the market and explore the town. Or a walk up to the castle which overlooks Cocentaina. 6kms (walk) 317 metres ascent.

**Friday 16**<sup>th</sup> **September.** After yesterday's rest, a hillier ride today to complete a circuit of the lake at Beniarres. A hilly start, which gets easier as the day goes on. 42kms, 717 metres ascent.
